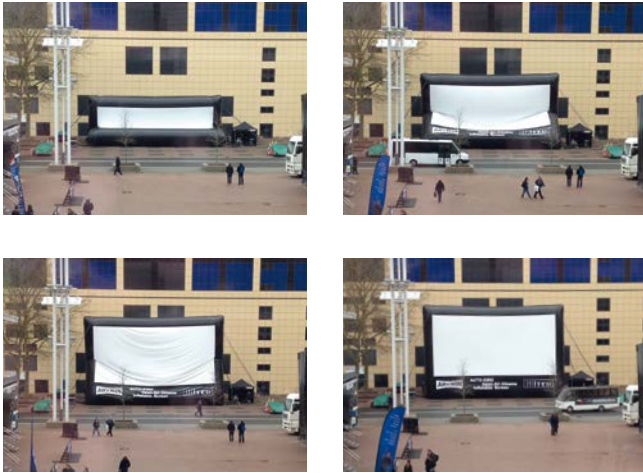

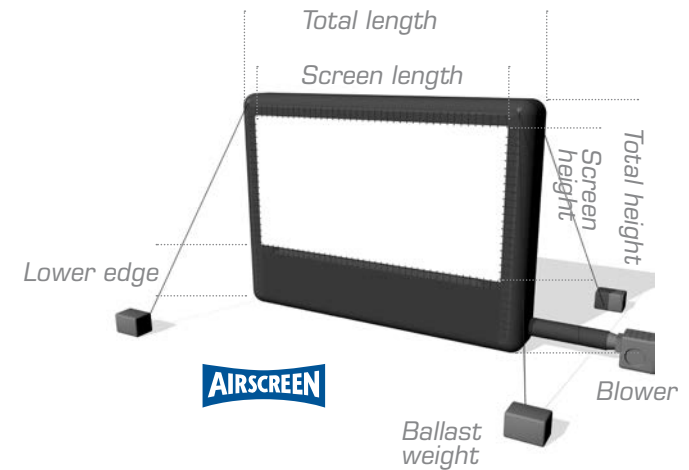

In case of sudden thunderstorms and strong winds, AIRSCREENS® may be fully deflated in only a few seconds. Inflating and re-erection takes as little as 5 to 10 minutes

There are manifold ways to project a good image onto a screen. This always depends on the screen size, the local conditions, and the project specifications.

The motion picture is digitally transmitted by a high-performance projector. The source is a hard drive and the motion picture is played on the basis of the internationally used DCI standard (Digital-Cinema-Initiatives).

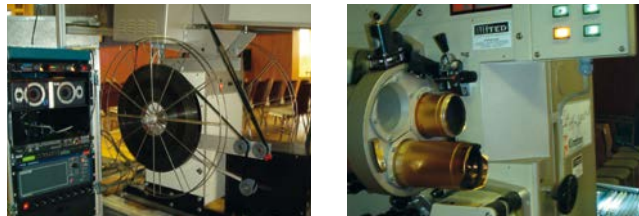
It is also possible to render other image formats stored on a DVD or BluRay, presentation charts or image files via digital movie projectors. Our portfolio includes a great variety of equipment for digital movie projection as well as the matching technical infrastructure such as server and digital audio mixing consoles. Our inventory is rounded off by the most different lens sizes in order to enable

us to also realise out-of-the-ordinary projection distances and image sizes.

If you rather prefer a classical solution, you may certainly also rely on movie projection using a 35 mm format, a system with a tradition of more than 100 years. Our state-of-the-art 35 mm movie projectors are capable of creating an unmistakable analogue movie image even

on the largest of screens, which is particularly effective with classic films, allowing the audience to immerse into a typical “cinema” atmosphere.

For quite some time audio transmissions in drive-in cinemas have no longer made use of standard loudspeakers, which require a cumbersome attachment inside the car, but rather employ an FM radio signal for transmission directly to the car’s radio. A digital sound sampling integrated into the movie projector provides perfect audio quality in genuine cinema format. And the best: The local residents are not annoyed by any noise!

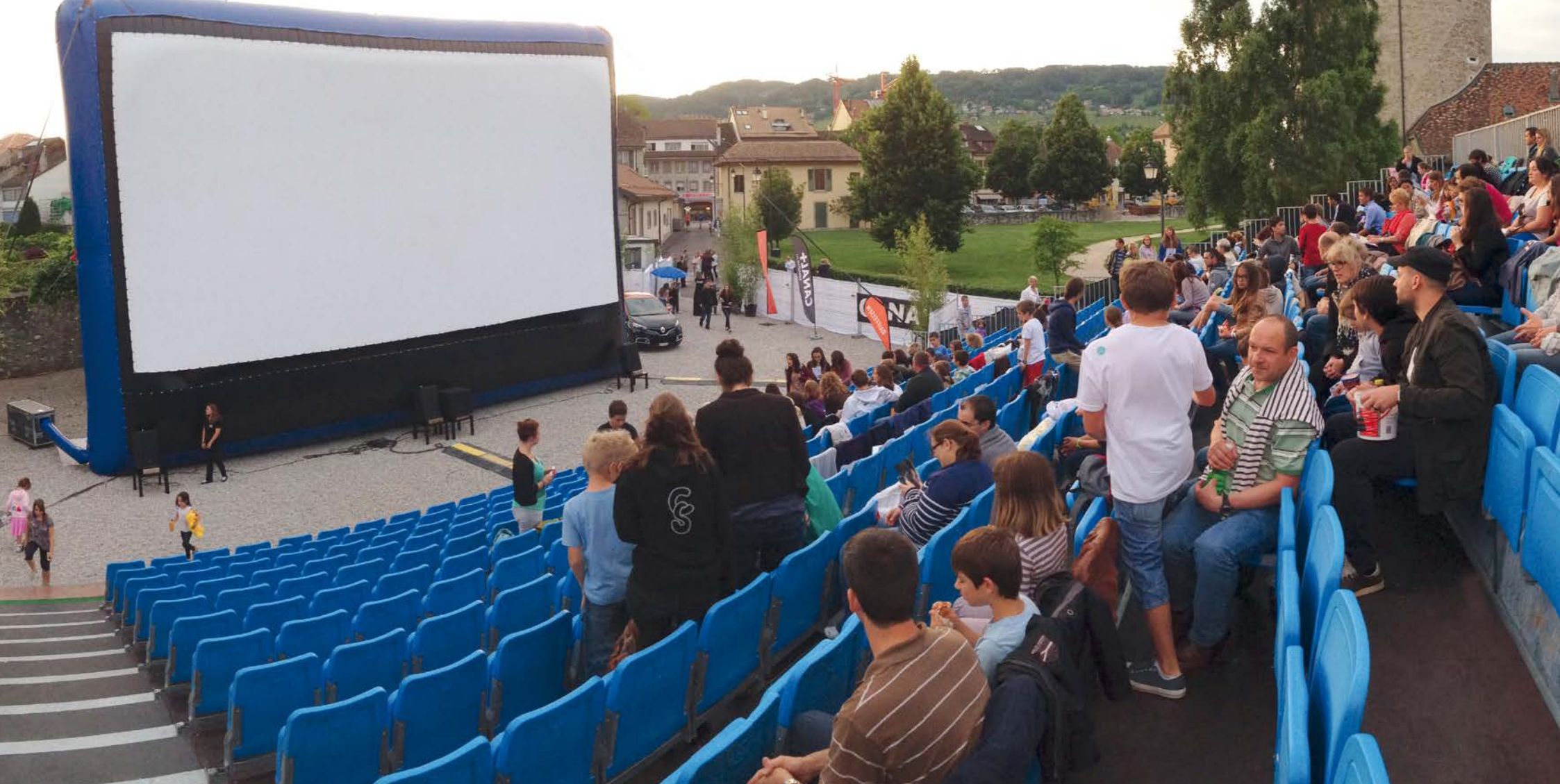

TECHNICAL IMPLEMENTATION

Screens may be properly ballasted in different ways:



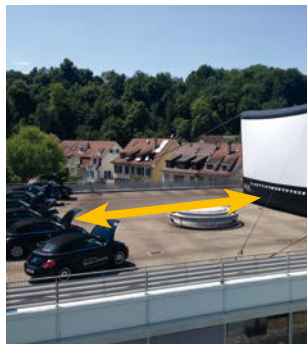
Floor slabs and ground anchors with a length of 1.00 meter each. This requires a previous verification using layout diagrams to determine if underground cables are present in the area concerned.



Ballast weights and tanks function as a reliable anchor on tarmac-covered squares.



Anchoring using existing building structures. Verification of the structural strength is mandatory for this.



Observe the minimum distance to the screen! We recommend a factor of 1.5 of the total screen frame height for calculation of the optimal distance to the screen in a drive-in cinema.

A safety distance to the screen, which corresponds to the overall height of the screen frame, is mandatory for an open-air cinema.



AIRSCREENs® are always supplied with a case that accommodates the screen blower and protects it against the weather. A specific sound insulation of the case is available on request.

The rear of the AIRSCREEN® frame may display an individual banner print – a genuine eye-catcher for your event.

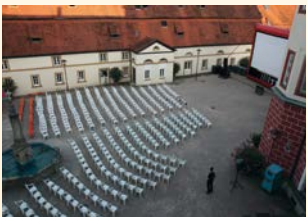
Part of our screens display our corporate logotype which may, however, be replaced on request.
